Sam Harris isn't shy, but neither is he wise. Repeat this quote slowly three times and watch people's faces.

The second is example L. Christopher Hitchens was bombastic, and he often made you aware of it. He seems to have ping-ponged between fatuous blowhard and thoughtful schoolboy. He was the member of the Traveling Medicine Show I would have liked the best, I think.

You must admit that he doesn't leave you guessing what his thoughts are toward your precious faith. I chose this quote for a reason that is more important than Christopher's clarity.
